

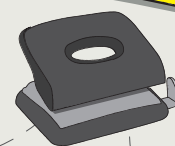
# How to make

## HERE'S WHAT YOU DO

### YOU'LL NEED:

- A PAIR OF SCISSORS
- A HOLE PUNCH
- LENGTH OF STRING OR COTTON
- GLUE

- A GROWN UP TO HELP CUT ALONG THE DOTTED LINES
- COLOURING PENCILS, PENS OR CRAYONS
- CARD OR CARDBOARD
- BLU-TACK OR SELLOTAPE

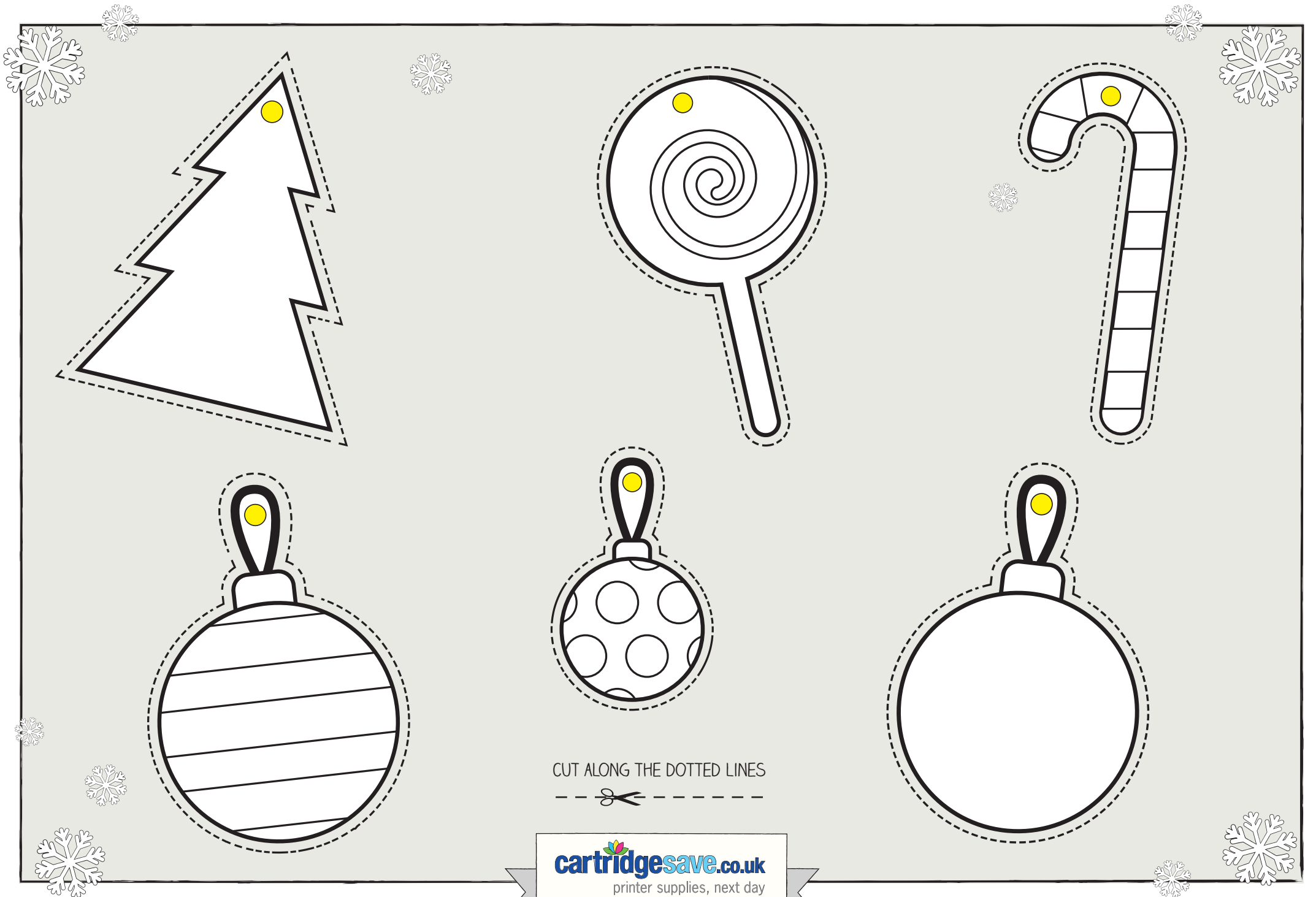

1. Print off the accompanying page full of Christmas baubles, trees, presents and candy canes as many times as required.
2. Personalise the decorations with bright and festive colours and patterns - the more colourful the better!
3. Glue the decorations face up onto a sheet of card or cardboard, once dried carefully cut them out following the dotted lines.
4. Punch a hole through the yellow circles in each decoration and begin to feed the string through each of the holes, spreading out your decorations as evenly as possible.
5. Choose a safe place to hang your garlands (ask an adult if you can't reach), and use blu-tack or sellotape to secure the ends of the string in place.
