

# How to Build

## An Igloo

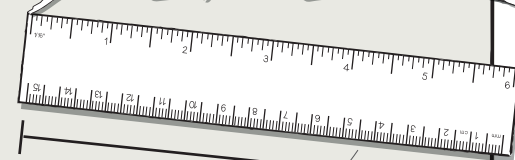
WITH AN ARCTIC WINTER SET TO BE ON THE HORIZON, EVER WONDERED HOW TO BUILD AN IGLOO? PERFECT FOR CHILDREN AGED 8+ OUR GUIDE SHOWS YOU HOW! JUST MAKE SURE YOU HAVE AN ADULT TO HELP OUT.

### HERE'S WHAT YOU DO

1. Create a large pile of snow with your shovel - larger than you need for your igloo.
2. Use your hands and a shovel to compress the snow so it is packed down hard, moulding the snow into a dome shape as you go.
3. Using a ruler, break up some twigs so they are approximately 6 inches long, then begin to insert them all around your igloo so the ends of the twigs are just visible at the surface.
4. Pick a good spot for a door, (Don't make more than one) and start to tunnel into the middle of your snow pile.
5. Once inside, start to burrow out your room being careful to stop when you see the ends of the twigs. Finally, use a longer twig or a pole to poke out a few air holes for ventilation.

#### YOU'LL NEED:

- LOTS & LOTS OF SNOW!
- A SHOVEL OR TROWEL
- A RULER
- SOME TWIGS  
(REMEMBER TO WRAP UP WARM!)
