

How to paint

an Easter Egg

IN KEEPING WITH THE EASTER TRADITION OF EGG ROLLING, WE'VE CREATED A STEP BY STEP GUIDE ON HOW TO DECORATE A HARD BOILED EGG! IT'S ONE THE WHOLE FAMILY CAN ENJOY.

HERE'S WHAT YOU DO

1. With an adult to help out, hard boil your egg in a saucepan then leave to cool before starting the fun part.
2. Choose your favourite colour pens and paint, lay down some old newspaper in the area you'll be painting and wear an apron or old clothes.
3. Get busy with your brushes and paint patterns or faces on your eggs. (We'll leave the creative part up to you!)
4. Place the eggs in an empty egg carton and leave the paint to dry, then start to add any glitter or stickers for extra decoration if you want to.
5. Once you're done, you can hide them for an Easter Egg hunt or even put them on display in a decorative basket!

YOU'LL NEED:

- EGGS
- READY MIX PAINT
- KITCHEN ROLL / NEWSPAPER
- PAINTBRUSHES

- A GROWN UP TO HELP BOIL THE EGGS
- CRAYONS, STICKERS, GLUE & GLITTER (SHOULD YOU WANT TO ADD MORE!)
- A SAUCEPAN (TO BOIL THE EGGS)
