- a. Submit a short story or poem of no more than 200 words

2) The competition is open to entries from 9th October 2017. All competition entries must be received by 5pm on 17th November 2017. All competition entries received after this date are automatically disqualified. One entry per person. Late, incomplete or illegible entries will not be accepted.

3) One overall winner will be chosen, plus two runners up. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into. Entries that are considered offensive or defamatory to any living person or organisation will not be considered.

4) Poems and short stories (less than 200 words) must be entered by a caregiver, parent or teacher over the age of 18 who can give permission for the story, name and age of the child to be included in the book and used in publicity.
